Bathandwa Kwatsha is a native of Port Elizabeth. A wife, a mother & a grandmother. She is a Kingdom & purpose driven teacher & healer through her ministry of the word & prayer. She is a conference speaker on women, religious, community & governmental matters & she empowers others through prayer gatherings, revivals, retreats, team building workshops & other events for men, women & young people who seek to develop a Godly character & live in the love of God.

She is the founder of "Beloved Gathering:" a non-denominational, mentorship non-profit organisation for young people & leaders which is aimed at CONNECTING PEOPLE TO THEIR GOD GIVEN DESTINIES.

Amongst the many hats she wears- she is a also a well known anchor of gospel programmes: "Hlalani kum, ndihlale kuni", "Ngenani Emasangweni Ngendumiso" & the much loved "IMVUSELELO" on two SABC radio stations: TruFM and Mhlobo Wenene respectively. With uMhlobo Wenene being the second biggest radio station in SA with listenership of about 5.4 million. She has long had a burden for children & children's ministry which became noticeable by her involvement & impact in children's lives all over South Africa.

In 1992 she contributed to & made a National footprint in the development of the South African Children's Charter. After her Diploma in Theology, she further obtained a Certificate in 2004 for handling abused and neglected children at Jackson's Ridge in Rustenburg. Her connection to & passion for young kids & children's ministry was cultivated when God connected her to children's ministers Rev. Ed & Ma Sonja Corbin who she had the pleasure of learning from and receiving impartation from a young age. She was an active member & Executive Director of Royal Family Kids' Camp- Eastern Cape for abused and neglected children where she got to raise children & young people in their God given gifts/ talents.

She served as a children's minister in her local Church in Bisho for a number of years helping to raise & mentor other children ministers as well. She also trained a lot of young people & groups in the following areas: Counselling, Handling of abused and neglected children, Team building & Leadership development.

In the early years of her ministry, she was Chairperson in the Port Elizabeth Children's Council; she was also a member of the Board of Directors for DOE cooperative and the Amathole District Children Advisory Council in 2010/2011. She has worked for the Independents Complaints Directorate on teenage pregnancy. Her INTERSESSORY & WORD HEALING ministry have exposed her to the Nations of the world: many seek & drink from God's well of healing through her ministry. This has also made her key to many National, Provincial and Local welfare matters. She has been part of governance matters like formulation of policies, Human Resources Management & Development, Project Management etc, thus relating in interaction with high profile personnel within the government sector.

She has a heart for restoring women, families & relationships. Amongst all her accomplishments, she considers raising Godly citizens in their God given destinies through prayer & the word (being one with God) her primary purpose. Following this, she was a missionary-children's ministry trainer with the Jackson's Ridge (JR) Children's Ministry Training Centre, training pastors and children's workers interdenominationally across Southern Africa. During this time, Charmaine specialized in experiential education, personality profiling, puppetry, ventriloquism, & Child Theology. After several years in informal training, Charmaine crossed over into Academia, spear-heading the launch of one of the first set of accredited occupational ministry certificates in South Africa. She modified the curricula to ensure the learning programme trains pastoral leaders for ministry that is inter-generational, child-friendly & social-justice orientated. In this capacity, Charmaine learned how to develop online programmes, & how to implement church-based work-sites for structured & supervised work-integrated learning. Her literary contributions include the groundbreaking "Hot Coffee Book," launched on April 30, 2021, and "Online Ministry - Embracing Online Preaching and Evangelism," released on April 30, 2023, as part of her theological research project at Twin Palm Leadership University.

In August 2023, Dorcas authored "Transformed to Harvest," with the book launch held in Abuja, Nigeria, and subsequently transferred ownership to God's General International Ministry. NEVILLE AND GAIL FANNIN

Neville and his wife Gail are missionaries who work towards the cause of children in Africa. They were the Directors of Jackson's Ridge Children's Ministries Training Centre for 15 years and have gone on to begin their own ministry called "Everything Kid's Ministry." They and their team travel extensively across sub-Saharan Africa to assist and support churches, church leaders and parents with children's ministry training. One of their greatest desires is to help our fathers "turn their hearts back to their children" which they do through running parenting seminars. This greatly assists the local church body to raise the level of ministry to children in the church and their communities.

In addition to this they run a variety of camping programs for children, including Royal Family Kids'
Camps which is a program for children whose lives have been devastated by abuse and neglect. The main focus of each camp is to lead each child into God's presence and facilitate a life changing experience.

They run the head office for Royal Family Africa and are the designated training centre for Royal Family Kid's Camps and Teen Reach Action Camps. They are also a training facility for DCPI which plants churches, especially focusing on the children as the springboard.

They have been ministering to children for over 35 years and their hearts burn with a passion to introduce children to Christ and to lead them to an authentic deeper walk with their Saviour. They advocate strongly for parents to disciple their children in their homes and believe that the Lord <u>charged</u> the whole community of believers to be involved with children's spiritual growth.

They develop and provide a wide variety of resources for children's ministers to support them to teach the Bible in a fun and exciting way. These resources include curriculum, puppets, illusions, visual aids, crafts and so much more.
